

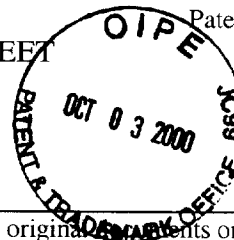

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THIS ASSIGNMENT is made as a deed on *22nd September* 2000
BETWEEN

(1) BTG INTERNATIONAL LIMITED whose company registration number in England and Wales is 2664412 and whose registered address is at 10 Fleet Place, Limeburner Lane, London, EC4M 7SB, England ("BTG"), and

(2) RANIER LIMITED whose company registration number in England is 3015156 and whose registered address is Fountain House, 25 City Road, Cambridge, CB1 1DP (the "COMPANY").

WHEREAS:-

A. BTG is the proprietor and/or beneficial owner of the applications, details of which are set out in the Schedule to this Agreement, together with related know-how and other rights (all such applications, know-how, and other rights are herein together called the "IPR").

B. Pursuant to a Revenue Sharing Agreement (the "REVENUE SHARING AGREEMENT") made between the COMPANY, Geoffrey Thomas Andrews, Robert Adam Snell and BTG and dated 21st January 1999 BTG has agreed that the IPR shall be assigned to the COMPANY on the terms hereinafter set forth.

NOW IT IS HEREBY AGREED as follows:-

1. BTG hereby assigns to the COMPANY all its right, title, and interest in the IPR, free from encumbrances, except for encumbrances disclosed or otherwise known to the COMPANY, and together with all rights transferable with such encumbrances.

2. (1) BTG shall, at the request and cost of the COMPANY, execute and do all such documents, acts and things as may be necessary on the part of BTG to give effect to the terms of this Agreement.

(2) BTG hereby confirms that, as at the date of this Agreement, it is not aware of any unauthorised use of any of the IPR.

(3) BTG shall, after the date of this Agreement, keep the IPR confidential, and not disclose it to any third party, except that this shall not apply to any of the IPR which is, or comes into, the public domain, otherwise than by BTG's default.

3. THE COMPANY hereby agrees with BTG that:-

(1) the COMPANY will, within 90 days after the date of receipt thereof, pay to BTG 50% of all payments (if any) received in respect of the licensing, manufacture, sale or other commercialisation of the IPR, until the aggregate of all such payments to BTG amounts to the sum of £8,939.48.

(2) the COMPANY will keep proper accounts of its receipts which are the subject of sub-clause (1) of this clause, and that it will on request produce the same for inspection by the duly authorised representative of BTG together with any invoices or vouchers relating thereto for the purpose of verification.

(3) the COMPANY will not, without the prior written consent of BTG, assign or otherwise part with possession of its rights in the IPR (except by way of licence thereunder) until the said sum of £8,939.48 has been paid to BTG.


4. IT is hereby agreed that BTG is released from its obligations under clause 8 of the Assignment dated 21st January 1999 made between the COMPANY, Geoffrey Thomas Andrews, Robert Adam Snell and BTG and the REVENUE SHARING AGREEMENT is hereby terminated with immediate effect.

5. THIS Agreement shall be read and construed in accordance with, and governed by, English law, and the parties submit to the jurisdiction of the English Courts.






