## ASSIGNMENT OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

THIS ASSIGNMENT OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY ("Assignment") is made this 28th day of August 2000 by The Procter & Gamble Company, an Ohio corporation, having its principal place of business at One Procter & Gamble Plaza, Cincinnati, Ohio 45202 ("Assignor") in favor of The University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center, a not-for-profit corporation organized under the laws of the State of Texas, with offices at 5323 Harry Hines Blvd., Dallas, Texas 75235-9094 (Assignee").

### RECITALS

The parties have executed that certain Donation Agreement dated 28 August 2000 (the "Agreement"), and Assignee desires to purchase, and Assignor desires to sell, the Intellectual Property, as that term is defined in the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

### AGREEMENT

#### RECITALS:

1. Assignment of Intellectual Property. Assignor hereby irrevocably grants, assigns and conveys to Assignee Assignor's entire right, title and interest in and to:

(a) The United States patents and applications for patent (including divisionals, continuations, reissues or reexaminations thereof) of Assignor described in Schedule A hereto;

(b) The inventions disclosed and/or claimed in all of said United States and foreign patents and applications for patent, and all other proprietary inventions now owned by Assignor or hereafter made, created or acquired by or for Assignor whether or not any of said inventions are patentable;


(c) All renewals, reissues, continuations, extensions or the like of any patents, and like protection, including without limitation, those obtained or permissible under past, present and future laws and statutes of the United States, any state or any other country or place anywhere in the world;

(d) All rights of action on account of past, present, and future unauthorized use of any of said patents, inventions and for infringement of said patents, inventions, and like protection;

(e) The right to file and prosecute applications for said patents, or for similar intellectual property in the United States or any other country or place anywhere in the world.
