

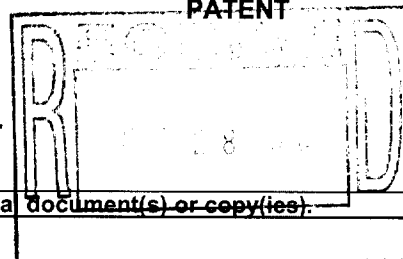

ASSIGNMENT OF PATENTS AND PATENT APPLICATIONS


