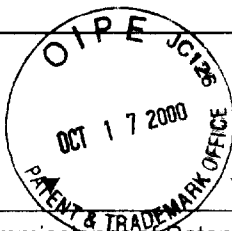

OF USING SAME**


for which an application for Letters Patent of the United States was filed on May 30, 2000 and assigned Serial No. 09/584,001; and
