RELEASE OF TRADEMARKS AND PATENTS

WHEREAS, the Secured Party wishes to release all of its interest in the Debtor's Collateral in the records of the United States Patent and Trademark Office;




This Release shall be governed in all respects by the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts without giving effect to the conflict of laws rules thereof.
