PATENT ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

This Patent Assignment Agreement ("Assignment"), effective as of August 24, 2000, by and between Fiber Sales & Development Corporation (hereinafter called "FS&D"), having its principal place of business at 1034 Danforth Dr., St. Louis, Missouri 63102, and International Fiber Corporation (hereinafter called "FIBER"), a company having its principal place of business at 1209 Orange Street, Wilmington, Delaware 19801.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the assets of FS&D are being sold to Fiber; and,

WHEREAS, for good and valuable consideration as set forth in the Asset Purchase Agreement between the parties for assignment of the technology and patent rights.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and the following terms and conditions, the sufficiency of which is acknowledged by both parties hereto, it is hereby agreed between the parties hereto as follows:

1. "FIBER PATENT RIGHTS" shall mean the patents and patent applications set forth in Schedule A attached hereto, including all extensions, continuations, continuations-in-part, divisions, patents of addition, reissues, and reexaminations thereof, and any subsequent filings in any country or jurisdiction claiming priority therefrom.
2. FS&D hereby assigns to FIBER all right, title, and interest in the FIBER PATENT RIGHTS. FS&D agrees that FIBER shall have all rights and powers arising or accrued with regard to the FIBER PATENT RIGHTS, including, without limitation, the right to sue for damages and other remedies in respect of any past and future infringement of such rights.
3. FS&D will cooperate fully in executing appropriate documents provided by FIBER to complete formalities for perfecting the assignment and recording of the FIBER PATENT RIGHTS. Said documents will include, but not be limited to: powers of attorney, letters of instruction, and letters to confirm assignment. All out-of-pocket costs associated with preparing and recording assignments shall be borne by FIBER.
4. For a period of ten (10) years from the date of this Assignment, FS&D hereby agrees to maintain any confidential FIBER PATENT RIGHTS in confidence in accordance

with the practice of FS&D to maintain information confidential, which shall not be less than a reasonable practice to maintain information confidential. FS&D's obligation to maintain the above information confidential shall not apply to any information which

(a) is in or becomes part of the public domain

(b) is lawfully received from a third party under no obligation of confidentiality to FS&D.

(c) is independently developed by or for FS&D as evidenced by written records;

or

(d) is required to be disclosed by operation of law.

5. This Assignment and the rights granted herein shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns.


6. Should any provision of this Assignment be declared unenforceable for any reason or found contrary to any law or statute, said provision will automatically cease to be part of this Assignment without affecting any other provision or obligation thereof.

7. Should this Assignment, or any provision thereof, be declared unenforceable for any reason in any country or legal jurisdiction, the Assignment, or the affected provision, shall not be affected in any other country or legal jurisdiction.

8. This Assignment shall be construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Delaware, without regard to choice of law provisions.


