ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, we, Thomas G. Lestina, residing at 1707 N. Monroe Street, Arlington, Virginia 22207; Melissa Bradley, residing at 110 Downey Drive, Apartment C, Manchester, Connecticut 06040; Ryan Downs, residing at 5446 Broadmoor Street, Alexandria, Virginia 22315; and Eric Runnerstrom, residing at 3135 Valley Lane, Falls Church, Virginia 22044, respectively, have invented certain new and useful improvements in Method and Apparatus for Detecting and Isolating a Rupture in a Fluid Distribution System, for which a provisional U.S. Patent Application Serial No. 60/162,241 was filed on October 28, 1999, and for which an application for United States Letters Patent is being concurrently filed herewith.
