**ASSIGNMENT**

WHEREAS, William R. McCormick residing at 10512 - 50th Avenue, Kenosha, Wisconsin 53142; Kelly M. Wolcott residing at 1714 - 35th Place, Kenosha, Wisconsin 53140; and Theodore J. Caron residing at 7616 - 10th Avenue, Kenosha, Wisconsin 53143, respectively (hereinafter referred to as Assignor), have invented certain new and useful improvements in BILLIARD BALL RACK for which an application for United States Letters Patent was executed on even date herewith.
