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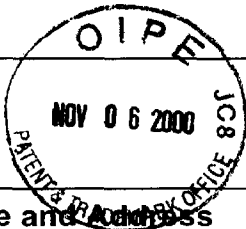



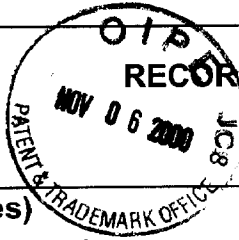

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ASSIGNMENT

Identity Of The Patent Application. I am the inventor (or one joint inventor) of a patent application that I am assigning. The patent application I am assigning is entitled Architecture for High Speed Memory Circuit Having a Relatively Large Number of Internal Data Lines. The patent application has already been filed. The rights I assign are my entire right, title and interest in the invention or improvements disclosed in the patent application and any and all other applications for Letters Patent of the United States and foreign countries which I may file, either solely or jointly with others, on the invention or improvements, including all continuations, divisionals, and continuations-in-part, and in any and all Letters Patent of the United States and foreign countries which may be obtained on any of said applications, and in any reissue or extension thereof. I also assign to the Assignees all priority rights under the International Convention. I further grant Assignees the right to apply for Letters Patent in foreign countries as applicants therein and to claim any priority rights for such foreign applications to which such applications are entitled under international conventions, treaties, or otherwise. Each Assignee shall have an equal, undivided one-half interest in all of the aforesaid right, title and interest in the invention or improvements, and in the aforesaid priority rights. I agree to execute, at the request of the Assignees, all documents in connection with any application, both United States and foreign countries, for Letters Patent therefor.
