 transactions involving such applications or patents.

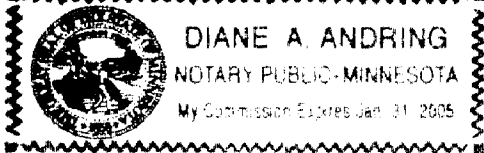
