WHEREAS, we executed under the Patent Cooperation Treaty International Application PCT/GB98/03293, in which we designated the United States of America, Canada, China, and the Russia Federation as designated States, and which was accorded an International Filing Date of November 3, 1998 and accorded a priority date of November 3, 1997 based on UK National Application 9723217.7.

WHEREAS, we represent and warrant that we are the joint inventors of said invention and applicants of said International Application for the purpose of obtaining United States Letters Patent;

WHEREAS, FAIRFIELD INDUSTRIES, INC., a Delaware corporation having its principal office at 14100 Southwest Freeway, Suite 600, Sugar Land, Texas 77478, and WIRELESS SYSTEMS INTERNATIONAL LIMITED, a United Kingdom corporation having its principal office at Innovation House, Bristol Business Park, Coldharbour Lane, Bristol BS16 1EJ, Great Britain, hereinafter referred to as "ASSIGNEES", are desirous of acquiring all right, title, and interest in and to the above-mentioned invention and patent applications;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged by us, we have assigned, sold, transferred and set over and by these presents do assign, sell, transfer and set over unto said ASSIGNEES, to be held jointly as tenants-in-common, each of the ASSIGNEES holding an undivided one-half share, the entire right, title and interest in and to (a) said invention and world-wide rights therein, (b) said applications, including all divisions, continuations, continuations-in-part and substitutions thereof, and (c) all United States and foreign patents which shall issue on said invention, including all reissues, renewals and extensions thereof, for the United States, its territories and possessions and all foreign countries, including the right to file applications for Letters Patent on said invention in any and all foreign countries, the same to be held and enjoyed by said ASSIGNEES, its assigns and successors, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by us, had this assignment and sale not been made.

We covenant and agree that we will, at any time upon the request and at the expense of said ASSIGNEES, execute and deliver any and all papers and do all lawful acts that may be necessary or desirable, in the opinion of said ASSIGNEES, to enable and assist said ASSIGNEES to (a) obtain Letters Patent, both domestic and foreign, on said invention, (b) establish, maintain and secure title in

said ASSIGNEES, its successors, and assigns, to said invention, applications and Letters Patent, including making such title of lawful public record, and (c) defend, establish or otherwise preserve the validity of said Letters Patent against any and all infringers, and perform such other acts as are necessary to give full force and effect to this assignment.

We hereby authorize and request the Commissioner of Patents of the United States of America to issue all Letters Patent based on said applications and all said divisions, continuations, continuations-in-part, reissues, renewals and extensions to said ASSIGNEES, its successors, and assigns.
