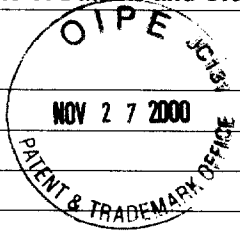

ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, we, **DAVID C. HOLLOCHER**, being a citizen of the United States, residing at 10 Mayfair Circle, Norwood, MA 02062, and, **JOHN MEMISHIAN**, being a citizen of the United States, residing at 1445 Commonwealth Avenue, Newton, MA 02465, are the inventors of certain new and useful inventions and discoveries, for which we have made an application for Letters Patent entitled

4. 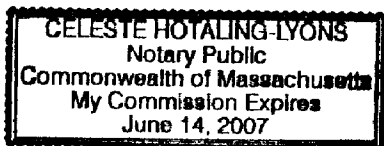



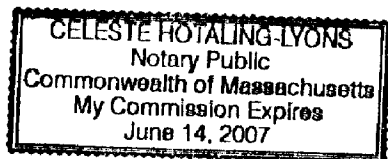
