Said Invention, application, and Letters Patent issuing from said application or continuation, continuation-in-part, or division thereof, and any reissue of any such patent, to be held and enjoyed by Longbore, Inc for its own use, and for its legal representatives and assigns as fully and entirely as the same would have been held by me had this assignment and sale not been made.

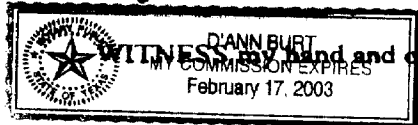
