

ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, I, Jack M. Schooley, of Vancouver, County of Clark, State of Washington, (hereinafter referred to as "SCHOOLEY") have invented certain improvements in LEVEL, for which I filed an application for Letters Patent of the United States on September 8, 2000. This application was given Serial No. 09/658,821.

WHEREAS, Jason R. Crowe, of Vancouver, County of Clark, and State of Washington, (hereinafter referred to as "CROWE") is desirous of acquiring an interest therein:

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, I the said SCHOOLEY have sold, assigned and transferred, and by these presents do sell, assign and transfer unto the said CROWE, an undivided forty-nine percent (49%) interest in, to and under the Property, while retaining the remaining undivided fifty-one percent (51%) interest in, to and under the Property.

IN ADDITION, the parties hereto agree to the following terms and conditions:

1. All net profits and income received from the exploitation of the Property, whether the net profits and income are in the form of money, stock or any other consideration, shall be shared by the parties proportionally to their respective interests.
2. The parties shall share proportionally to their respective interest in any damages awarded as a result of any infringement of any patents granted for said invention.
3. A party's interest shall survive the party's death and shall be disposed of

by will or under applicable laws of intestate succession.

4. Except as provided in paragraph 3 above, no party shall transfer his undivided interest or any portion thereof without the prior written consent of the other party.

5. Any party who grants a license under his interest in the Property to a third party shall promptly provide the other party with a copy of the license agreement.


