**ASSIGNMENT OF INVENTION AND

Furthermore, the Inventor agrees to take all necessary and rightful oaths, to execute all proper documents and to do all other things necessary and proper, at the Assignee's expense, to assist the Assignee in securing, obtaining and maintaining patent protection for the invention in the United States of America and in any and all country(ies) throughout the world.

If any provision of this agreement shall be found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, unlawful, or contrary to public policy, the Assignee and Assignor intend that such provision shall be severed from this agreement and that the remaining terms of this agreement shall be unaffected thereby and shall continue in force and effect.
