

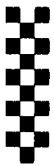

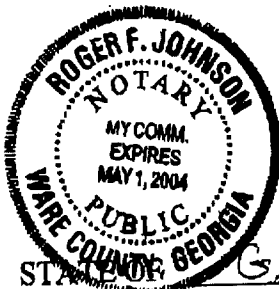
PATENT ASSIGNMENT
