## **ASSIGNMENT OF INVENTION**

WHEREAS, I, Roberto O. Pellizzari, along with Kenneth Kensey, William N. Hogenauer, John E. Nash, Harold E. Clupper, Sangho Kim, Young Cho, Peter Randolph Hazard Stark and Sergey Kruss, residing at 95 Raddin Road, Groton, MA 01450, have made a certain new and useful invention in the DUAL RISER/DUAL CAPILLARY VISCOMETER FOR NEWTONIAN AND NON-NEWTONIAN FLUIDS (hereinafter "invention"), and have filed an application for Letters Patent of the United States based thereon, which application was filed in the United States Patent and Trademark Office on July 12, 2000 and assigned Application Serial No. 09/615,340;

LITTLE, INC., and for one year thereafter, in and to said application for Letters Patent and any and all Letters Patent and extensions thereof of the United States and countries foreign thereto which have been or may be granted on said invention or any part thereof, or any improvements thereon or on said application, or any divisional, continuing, renewal, reissue, or other application and all international priority rights associated therewith, based in whole or in part thereon, or based upon said invention, or any improvements thereon;

TO BE HELD AND ENJOYED by the said ARTHUR D. LITTLE, INC. and its legal representatives and assigns to the full ends of the terms for which said Letters Patent, or any of them, have been granted or may be granted as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by me and ARTHUR D. LITTLE, INC. had no sale and assignment of said interest been made; and I and ARTHUR D. LITTLE, INC. do hereby authorize and request the Commissioner for Patents and Trademarks to issue any and all Letters Patent which may be granted upon the said invention above referred to, or any of them, or upon said invention or any part thereof, or upon any improvements thereon which may be made, conceived or acquired by me pursuant to my employment by ARTHUR D. LITTLE, INC. and for one year thereafter, to said ARTHUR D. LITTLE, INC., and I hereby

agree for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to execute without further consideration, any further legal documents and any further assignments and any releases, reissues, renewals or other applications for Letters Patent that may be deemed necessary by the Assignee herein named, fully to secure to the said Assignee its interest as aforesaid in and to said invention or any part thereof or any improvements thereon, and in and to said several Letters Patent, or any of them.

I do hereby covenant for myself and my legal representatives, and agree with ARTHUR D. LITTLE, INC., and its legal representatives, that I have granted no license to make or sell the said invention, that prior to the execution of this deed my rights, title and interest in the said invention has not been encumbered, that I then had good right and title in and to the invention and that I have not executed and will not execute any instrument in conflict therewith.


