ASSIGNMENT AND AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, **SVEND ANDERSEN**, a citizen of Canada, hereinafter called the "Assignor," has invented an **ELECTRICAL CONNECTOR** (Case 905-1000), for a full description of which, reference is herein made to an application for Letters Patent of the United States executed by Assignor on DECEMBER 5, 2000; and

WHEREAS, **RICHARD S. EISEN** of Northbrook, Illinois, hereinafter called the "Assignee," is desirous of acquiring an undivided 45% share of the entire right, title and interest in and to the invention above identified, the application above identified, and in, to and under any Letters Patents that may be obtained for the invention, as hereinafter more fully set forth.

NOW, THEREFORE, TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN, be it known that in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable and legally sufficient considerations, the receipt of which by the Assignor from the Assignee is hereby acknowledged, the Assignor does hereby sell, assign and transfer unto the Assignee an undivided 45% part of the entire right, title and interest in and to the invention and application hereinabove identified, and any Letters Patents of the United States that may issue for the invention and in and to all divisions, continuations, and reissues thereof and substitutions of or for the application, to have and to hold for the sole and exclusive use and benefit of the Assignee, his successors and assigns, to the full end of the term or terms for which any and all of the Letters Patents for the invention

may issue; and the Assignor also sells, assigns and transfers unto the Assignee an undivided 45% share of the entire right, title and interest in and to the invention and applications for Letters Patents in all countries foreign to the United States, including all rights under the International Convention in respect of the invention and the application for Letters Patents in foreign countries.

Assignee agrees to pay all costs arising during the prosecution of the above designated patent application so long as he deems such prosecution reasonably worthwhile, and further agrees at his own expense to assist Assignor in the sale or licensing of the invention.

And Assignor does hereby covenant and agree, for himself and his legal representatives, that he will assist the Assignee in the prosecution of the application herein identified, in the making and prosecution of any other applications for Letters Patent that the Assignee may elect to make covering the invention herein identified, as hereinbefore set forth, and in the prosecution of any interference that may arise involving the invention, or any application or Letters Patent herein contemplated; and that he will execute and deliver to the Assignee any and all additional papers that may be requested to the Assignee to fully carry out the terms of this assignment.


