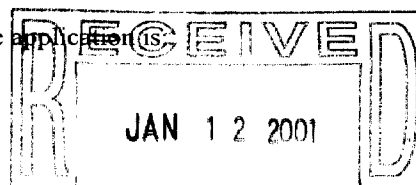

I/We hereby acknowledge that this assignment, being of the entire right, title and interest in and to said invention, carries with it the right in Institute to apply for and obtain from competent authorities in all countries of the world any and all Letters Patent by attorneys and agents of Institute's selection and the right to procure the grant of all such Letters Patent to Institute in its own name as assignee of the entire right, title and interest therein.

I/we will, at Institute's expense, perform all lawful acts that Institute, its successors, assigns, nominees and legal representatives may deem advisable to carry out the true purposes and intent hereof and I/we will assist Institute, its successors, assigns, nominees and legal representatives, in every lawful way to obtain, sustain and enforce Letters Patent for said invention, in all countries of the world, as and when requested by Institute, including specifically, but without limitation, the following:

- (a) I/we will communicate to Institute all facts known to us respecting said invention;

- (b) I/we will, as and when requested by Institute, execute all lawful papers which Institute may deem advisable for carrying out the true purposes and intent hereof, including all lawful oaths and affidavits, one or more written confirmations of this assignment, all applications for Letters Patent in foreign countries and all divisional, continuation, continuation-in-part, reissue and substitute applications for Letters Patent for said invention:
- (c) I/we will testify in any legal proceedings which involve said invention or any Letters Patent granted therefor.

I/we acknowledge and agree that the obligations recited herein are binding on us and on our heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
