**ASSIGNMENT OF UNITED STATES
PATENTS AND PENDING PATENT APPLICATIONS**

WHEREAS, OUTBOARD MARINE CORPORATION, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware, having a place of business at 100 Sea Horse Drive, Waukegan, IL 60085-2195 ("ASSIGNOR"), is the owner of a certain United States patents and pending United States patent applications identified in Exhibit A attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein (the "Patents," or "Applications," respectively); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that certain agreement entitled, "Asset Purchase Agreement" entered into by and between ASSIGNOR and JTC Acquisition LLC ("JTC"), a limited liability company organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware, on February 2, 2001 (the "Asset Purchase Agreement"), ASSIGNOR has agreed to assign to JTC, or its designee, its entire rights, title, and interests in and to the Patents and Applications identified in Exhibit A, including any patents which issue from said applications; and

WHEREAS, in order to effectuate ASSIGNOR's assignment of its entire rights, title and interests in and to the Patents and Applications to JTC's designee, Genmar IP LLC, a limited liability company organized under the laws of the State of Delaware ("ASSIGNEE"), ASSIGNOR is executing this instrument of assignment.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which are hereby acknowledged, ASSIGNOR does hereby sell, assign, convey and transfer to ASSIGNEE, its successors, assigns and legal representatives, its full and entire rights, title and interests in and to: the Patents and Applications, and/or the inventions disclosed and claimed therein, and any continuations, continuations-in part, divisional and/or foreign application thereof (said applications to be included within the meaning of the term Applications, as used herein) and any patents which may be granted on the Applications ("Future Patents"), and any reissue applications pertaining to any of the Patents or Future Patents, and any re-examinations of any of the Patents or Future Patents, the same to be held and enjoyed by ASSIGNEE for its own use and enjoyment and for the use and enjoyment of its successors, assigns, and legal representatives, to the end of the terms for which the Patents or Future Patents are or may be granted or reissued.

ASSIGNOR hereby agrees that ASSIGNEE shall have the right to record this instrument of assignment in the United States Patent and Trademark Office, and this instrument so as to establish ASSIGNEE as owner of record of all Patents, Future Patents and Applications, and the inventions disclosed and claimed therein, as the case may be, in the United States.

ASSIGNOR further agrees, at the request of ASSIGNEE and without charge or cost to ASSIGNEE (other than reimbursement of out-of-pocket expenses which are reasonably incurred), to: (i) execute and have executed any and all other documents of any kind whatsoever, and to provide any information in Assignor's possession or under its control that may be reasonably required to carry out the terms and intent of this Assignment; and (ii) fully cooperate with ASSIGNEE, as reasonably required, to enable ASSIGNEE to duly record this instrument of assignment with the United States Patent and Trademark Office so that ASSIGNEE's ownership

of the Patents, Future Patents and Applications, and the inventions disclosed and claimed therein, is duly made of record in the United States.

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary herein, ASSIGNOR makes no representations or warranties regarding the Patents, or patent applications, except as and to the extent set forth in the Asset Purchase Agreement. This Assignment is subject and subordinate to all of the terms and provisions of the Asset Purchase Agreement, and in the event of any conflict between any term or provision hereof and any term or provision of the Asset Purchase Agreement, the latter shall control.
