Whereas SoftWIRE Technology LLC, whose address is 16 Commerce Boulevard, Middleboro, Massachusetts 02346, and which, together with its successors and assigns, is hereinafter called "Assignee," is desirous of acquiring the title, rights, benefits, and privileges hereinafter recited;

Now, Therefore, for valuable consideration furnished by Assignee to Assignor, receipt and sufficiency of which Assignor hereby acknowledges, Assignor hereby, without reservation:

1. Assigns, transfers and conveys to Assignee its entire right, title, and interest in and to said applications for Letters Patent of the United States of America, any and all other applications for Letters Patent on said inventions and discoveries in whatsoever countries, including all divisional, renewal, substitute, continuation, continuation-in-part, and Convention applications based in whole or in part upon said inventions or discoveries, or upon said applications, and any and all Letters Patent, reissues, reexaminations, and extensions of Letters Patent granted for said inventions and discoveries or upon said applications, and every priority right that is or may be predicated upon or arise from said inventions, said discoveries, and said patent applications;

2. Authorizes Assignee to file the patent applications in any or all countries on any or all of said inventions and discoveries under the International Convention or otherwise;

3. Authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States of America and the empowered officials of all other governments to issue or transfer all said patent applications to Assignee, as assignee of the entire right, title, and interest therein or otherwise as Assignee may direct.

4. Warrants that it has not knowingly conveyed to others any right in said inventions, discoveries, or patent applications or any license to use the same or to make, use or sell or offer for sale anything embodying or utilizing any of said inventions,
