aforesaid benefit of the right of priority provided by the International Convention for the Protection of
Industrial Property, as amended, or by any convention which may henceforth be substituted for it.

AND we hereby covenant that we have the full right to convey the entire right, title and interest
herein assigned and that we have not executed and will not execute any agreement in conflict herewith.

AND we hereby covenant and agree that we will communicate to said Assignee or nominees all
facts known to us pertaining to said inventions, and testify in all legal proceedings, sign all lawful papers,
