And BORDEN CHEMICAL hereby authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks or other authority responsible for effectuating and/or recording assignments in the country involved, to issue any and all Letters Patent covering said inventions, or resulting from the aforesaid patents to GEORGIA-PACIFIC and to indicate thereon GEORGIA-PACIFIC, as the assignee of the entire right, title and interest in and to said Letters Patent and inventions described and claimed on the attached Exhibit "A".

And BORDEN CHEMICAL further covenants and agrees that it will at any time, upon GEORGIA-PACIFIC's request, and at GEORGIA-PACIFIC's expense, execute and deliver any and all papers that may be necessary or desirable to perfect the title to said inventions, or any Letters Patent that may be granted therefore to GEORGIA-PACIFIC or its successors, assigns or other legal representatives, and that if its successors, assigns or other legal representatives desire to secure a reissue, continuation, continuation-in-part or extension, or division of any Letters Patent, BORDEN CHEMICAL will, upon request, sign all papers, make all rightful oaths, and do all legal acts, necessary and requisite for application of such reissue, extension or division and the procuring thereof, without demanding any further consideration thereof.
