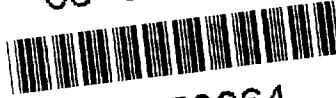



and will not execute any agreement or conveyance in conflict herewith.


