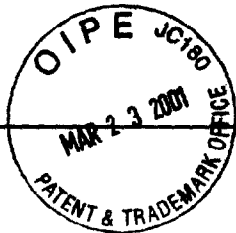

## ASSIGNMENT OF INTEREST

Comes now the undersigned, Mike Fagan and Mark Fagan, hereinafter referred to as assignors, and Vinyl Corners, Inc., a corporation duly formed under the laws of the State of Tennessee, hereinafter referred to as assignee:

Whereas, the undersigned, by entering into this agreement, do hereby declare their intention for the assignors to assign all benefits and interests which they may have or may hereafter acquire, in a patent in a vinyl cornerpart, more particularly identified in Appendix A; whereas, the assignors have applied for a United States patent for a vinyl corner molding, which is the purpose for forming Vinyl Corners, Inc., and they have been assigned a patent pending number;
