(1) the ASSIGNOR's entire right, title and interest in and to the Patents, and in and to the inventions disclosed therein, improvements thereon, and all divisional, continuing, substitute, renewal, reissue and all other applications for Letters Patent which have been or shall be filed in the United States and all foreign countries, free and clear of all liens and encumbrances; and

(2) the right to sue for past, present and future infringement of the Patents.

ASSIGNOR agrees that said Assignee may apply for and receive Letters Patent for said improvements in its own name, and that, when requested, said ASSIGNEE, its successors, assigns and legal representatives, to carry out in good faith the intent and purpose of this assignment, and the undersigned will execute, or will cause its agents or employees to execute, all divisional, continuing, substitute, renewal, reissue, and all other patent applications on any and all said improvements; execute all rightful oaths, assignments, powers of attorney and other papers, communicate to said ASSIGNEE, its successors, assigns, and representatives, all facts known to ASSIGNOR relating to said improvements and the history thereof; and otherwise to do or cause to be done all such other acts and things as may be reasonably necessary for aiding in securing and maintaining proper patent protection for said improvements and for vesting title to said improvements and all applications for patents and all patents on said improvements, in said ASSIGNEE, its successors, assigns and legal representatives;

ASSIGNOR further agrees to cooperate with ASSIGNEE in enforcing the Patents;

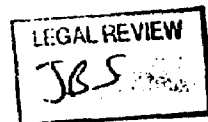
ASSIGNOR covenants with said ASSIGNEE, its successors, assigns and legal representatives that no assignment, grant, mortgage, license or other agreement affecting the
