## ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, I, **Patrick H. Wnek**, of Sherwood, Wisconsin, have invented certain new and useful improvements in a CONTAINER WITH IMPROVED STACKING/DENESTING CAPABILITY, for which an application for Letters Patent of the United States has been made, said application may be identified in the United States Patent Office by Application No. 09/764,718, filed 18 January 2001.


