The foregoing assignment includes any and all causes of action and claims for damages by reason of infringement of the Patents, or any of them, which causes of action and claims arose prior to the date of execution hereof, together with the right to sue for and collect the same for Assignee's own use, benefit and enjoyment, and for the use, benefit and enjoyment of its successors, assigns and legal representatives.

Assignors hereby agree that Assignee shall have the right to record this instrument of assignment in the United States Patent and Trademark Office, the United Kingdom Patent Office or other governmental office, and this instrument so as to establish Assignee as owner of record of future Patents, and the inventions disclosed and claimed therein.

Assignors further agree, at the request of Assignee and at sole cost and expense of Assignee, to: (i) execute and have executed any and all other documents of any kind whatsoever, and to provide whatever information may be required, to carry out the terms and intent of this Assignment; and (ii) fully cooperate with Assignee, as reasonably required, to enable Assignee to duly record this instrument of assignment so that Assignee's ownership of the Patents, and the inventions disclosed and claimed therein, is duly made of record.


