## ASSIGNMENT OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

Whereas, Thomas E. Reynolds (hereinafter "Trustee"), being trustee in the bankruptcy case of *In re Samuel Clayton Davis and Rose Ann Davis* (Case No. 00-06564-BGC-7, U.S. Bankruptcy Court, N.D. Ala., S. Div.), has full authority to transfer the property described herein on behalf of Samuel Clayton Davis and Rose Ann Davis, both individuals of Birmingham, Alabama, (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Davis");


Whereas, Davis are the owners of the trademark "THE SIPOS SYSTEM" and federal trademark application Serial No. 76/045127 for registration of "THE SIPOS SYSTEM and Design" (hereinafter collectively referred to as "the SIPOS trademark"); and U.S. Patent No. 5833319, issued November 10, 1998, and U.S. Patent No. 5456519, issued October 10, 1995, both patents entitled "BACK CUSHION AND SEAT CUSHION SYSTEM" (hereinafter collectively referred to as "the Patents");

Whereas, TransVision, LLC, of McCalla, Alabama (hereinafter "TransVision"), is desirous of acquiring the entire interest of Davis in and to the SIPOS trademark and the Patents;

Now, therefore, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, Trustee does hereby sell, assign and transfer to TransVision all of Davis' right, title and interest in and to the SIPOS trademark, together with the goodwill of the business symbolized by the SIPOS trademark and common law rights thereto; and the Patents and the inventions described therein, including related know-how, and all reissues and extensions of the Patents, and all forms of protection which may be granted for the inventions in the United States or any foreign country or countries; the same to be held and enjoyed by TransVision, for its own use and benefit and that of its successors, assigns and legal representatives, together with all claims for damages by reason of past infringement, with the right to sue for and collect the same for its own use and for the use of its successors, assigns or other legal representatives.


Trustee represents and warrants to TransVision that he has full right, power and authority to make this assignment to TransVision in the manner set forth above, and that Trustee is transferring to TransVision good and marketable title to the SIPOS trademark and the Patents, free and clear of all liens, security interests, claims, interests, options, encumbrances, or indebtedness of any kind.
