## ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, WE, CHARLES E. FARLEY, a citizen of the United States of America residing at 3150 Spring Lake Drive, Conyers, Georgia 30013, GEORGE ANDERSON, a citizen of the United States of America residing at 3655 E. Fairview Road, Stockbridge, Georgia 30281, and KARLA D.
