RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST**(Patents)**

THIS LIMITED RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST (Patents) is made as of this 27th day of April, 2001, by Texas State Bank, a Texas corporation, having an address at 3900 North 10th Street, McAllen, Texas 78501 ("Releasor") in favor of International Isotopes, Inc., a Texas corporation, having an address at 3100 Jim Christal Road, Denton, Texas 76207, ("Debtor").

WHEREAS, Debtor and Releasor executed a security agreement dated October 9, 1998 ("Security Agreement") under which the Debtor's right, title and interest in and to certain assets including all patent rights owned by the Debtor (referred to herein as "Encumbered Patents") were assigned for the benefit of the Releasor to secure payment and performance in full of certain obligations of the Debtor under a loan agreement dated October 9, 1998 ("Loan Agreement");

WHEREAS, for good and valuable consideration Releasor has agreed to release its security interest and lien in two patent applications of the Encumbered Patents;

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, Releasor hereby waives, releases, relinquishes and abandons any and all liens or security interests, and any and all claims of liens or security interests, of any kind or nature, in and to U.S. Patent Application, Serial No. 09/569,536 filed May 12, 2000, and entitled "System and Automated Method for Producing Welded End Closures in Thin-Walled Metal Tubes"; and U.S. Patent Application, Serial No. 09/672,567 filed September 28, 2000, and entitled "Fast Photon Counting Assay System and Method", and all foreign counterparts of such patent applications (hereinafter the "Released Patents"), all renewals, divisions, continuations, renewals, extensions and continuations-in-part, all rights to make, use and sell, and all other rights, with respect to, the inventions disclosed or claimed in the Released Patents, all inventions, designs, proprietary or technical information, and related documentation, and all rights not described above relating to the Released Patents, and all proceeds of any of the foregoing (such as, by way of example, license royalties and proceeds of infringement suits), the same to be held and enjoyed by Debtor for its own use and behalf and for its successors, legal representatives, and assigns to the full end of the term of any patents issuing from said Released Patents as fully and entirely as the same would have been held by Releasor had this assignment and release not been made, including all claims for profits and damages by reason of infringement by any party or parties, with the right to sue for and collect the same for Debtor's own use and behalf and for the use and behalf of Debtor's successors, assigns, and other legal representatives. The foregoing release includes, without limitation, a release of only the liens and security interests arising with respect to the Released Patents by virtue of the Security Agreement.

Releasor expressly retains its security interest and lien in all Encumbered Patents not specifically released hereunder, and the security interest and lien held by Releasor shall continue in full force and effect with respect to all Encumbered Patents not specifically released hereunder. Releasor agrees to execute such other documents and assurances as may be reasonably necessary to carry out the intent of this Release of Security Interest.

This Release of Security Interest shall be binding upon Releasor and its successors and assigns.

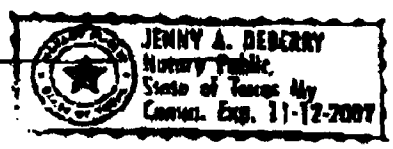
