desirable to perfect the assignee's enjoyment of this grant, and render all necessary assistance in making application for and obtaining original, divisional, reissued or extended Letters Patent of the United States, or of any and all foreign countries on said inventions, and in enforcing any rights, occurring as a result of such applications or patents, by giving testimony in any proceedings or transactions involving such applications or patents.

I further covenant that I am the sole owner of all right, title and interest in said inventions and said applications, that I know of no others who claim to have competing rights and that I have no knowledge of any security interest or other encumbrance upon said inventions and said applications.
