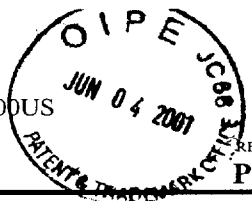

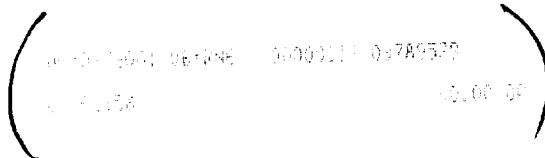

Assignment Of Application

WHEREAS, WE, Naoki YASUDA, Kyuji IHARA, Takeo TANAKA, and Masaharu AKITSU, of c/o Ajinomoto Fine-Techno Co., Inc., No. 1-2, Suzuki-cho, Kawasaki-ku, Kawasaki-shi, Kanagawa-ken 210-0801 JAPAN, c/o Sankyo Organic Chemicals Co., Ltd., No. 788, Kuji, Takatsu-ku, Kawasaki-shi, Kanagawa-ken 213-0032 JAPAN, c/o Ajinomoto Fine-Techno Co., Inc., No. 1-2, Suzuki-cho, Kawasaki-ku, Kawasaki-shi, Kanagawa-ken 210-0801 JAPAN, and c/o Sankyo Organic Chemicals Co., Ltd., No. 788, Kuji, Takatsu-ku, Kawasaki-shi, Kanagawa-ken 213-0032 JAPAN, respectively, have invented certain new and useful improvements in FLAME-RETARDED THERMOPLASTIC RESIN COMPOSITION, for which an application for Letters Patent was executed on May 16, 2001 (Application No. 09/789,539, filed February 22, 2001), and

WHEREAS, AJINOMOTO CO., INC. WE hereby authorize and request the Patent Office Officials in the United States and its territorial possessions and any and all foreign countries to issue any and all of said Letters Patent, when granted, to said ASSIGNEE as the assignee of our entire right, title and interest in and to the same, for the sole use and behoof of said ASSIGNEE, its successors and assigns, to the full end of the term for which said Letters Patent may be granted, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held by us had this Assignment and sale not been made.

Further, WE agree that WE will communicate to said ASSIGNEE or its representatives any facts known to us respecting said invention, and testify in any legal proceeding, sign all lawful papers, execute all divisional, continuation, substitute, renewal and reissue application, execute all necessary assignment papers to cause any and all of said Letter Patent to be issued to said ASSIGNEE, make all rightful oaths, and, generally do everything possible to aid said ASSIGNEE, its successors and assigns, to obtain and enforce proper protection for said invention in the United States and its territorial possessions and in any and all foreign countries.
