ASSIGNMENT OF U.S. PATENT RIGHTS

WHEREAS:

A. A-C Compressor Corporation, a Delaware corporation, having a place of business at 401 E. South Island Street, Appleton, Wisconsin 54915 (hereinafter referred to as "A-C Compressor"), owns the patents, patent applications, and the inventions embodied therein, identified in Schedule A attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and

B. Delaware Capital Formation, Inc., a Delaware corporation, having a place of business at 1403 Foulkstone Plaza, Suite 102, Wilmington, Delaware 19803 (hereinafter referred to as "Delaware Capital"), has agreed to acquire from A-C Compressor and A-C Compressor has agreed to sell to Delaware Capital all of A-C Compressor's interest in the patents, patent applications, and inventions embodied therein identified in Schedule A.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged:



A-C Compressor hereby sells, assigns and transfers to Delaware Capital, its successors and assigns, A-C Compressor's entire right, title and interest in and to the patents, patent applications, and inventions covered thereby and improvements thereto identified in Schedule A attached hereto, and any and all continuations, divisions, continuations-in-part, extensions or reissues thereof, together with all rights, interests and obligations running toward or granted to A-C Compressor under any previously executed assignment agreements between the inventor of each invention embodied in each patent or application therefor listed on Schedule A attached hereto and A-C Compressor or any of its predecessors in title; and together with any and all claims and demands A-C Compressor (either itself or through its predecessors) may have, at law or in equity, whether presently known, unknown, accrued or to accrue, arising out of past or present infringements of such patents, including the right to recover all claims for damages and compensation. Such right, title and interest shall be held and enjoyed by Delaware Capital, its successors and assigns, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by A-C Compressor if this assignment and sale had not been made.

2. A-C Compressor further agrees that it will promptly execute and deliver to Delaware Capital or its legal representatives any and all papers, instruments or affidavits that may be required to effect the intent of this assignment or to vest in Delaware Capital full right, title and interest in and to the respective patents or applications therefor listed on Schedule A attached hereto, or to maintain and enforce such patents and patent applications.

3. A-C Compressor hereby covenants that it will not at any time in the future execute any agreement in conflict herewith.


