said Letters Patent.

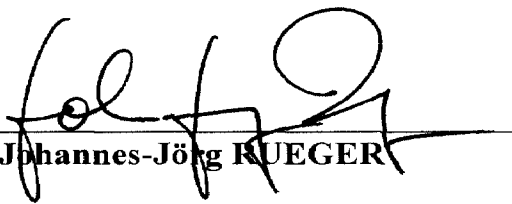
2. Authorize Assignee to file patent applications in any or all countries for any or
