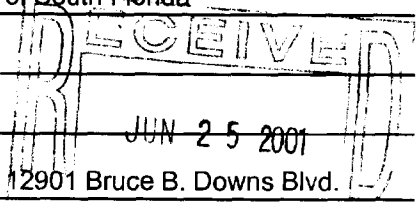

ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, we, Paul Sanberg, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at 11751 Pilot Country Drive, Spring Hill, FL 34610, Juan Sanchez-Ramos, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at 10435 Canary Isle Drive, Tampa, FL 33647, and Alison Willing, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at 13014 North Dale Mabry #266, Tampa, FL 33618, have invented new and useful improvements in "Human Cord Blood As a Source of Neural Tissue for Repair of the Brain and Spinal Cord" for which we filed patent application number 09/801,221 in the United States Patent and Trademark Office on March 7, 2001 and PCT application number PCT/US01/07200, filed March 7, 2001, said applications claiming priority from U.S. provisional application numbers 60/188,069 and 60/269,238, which were filed on March 9, 2000 and February 16, 2001. 

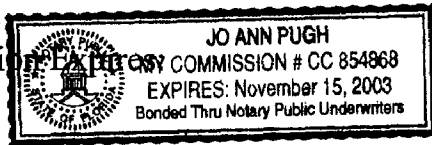
