
WHEREAS, I, GREGG A. DEAN, of HAMPSHIRE, ENGLAND, have invented certain new and useful improvements in METHOD FOR CAST MOLDING TORIC CONTACT LENSES, for which a patent application for United States Letters Patent thereon was filed on March 22, 2000, and accorded Serial No. 09/533,319.

will testify in any legal proceeding, sign all lawful papers, execute all divisional, reissue and continuation applications, and generally do everything possible to aid said Assignee, its successors and assigns, to obtain and enforce proper patent protection for said invention in all countries.


