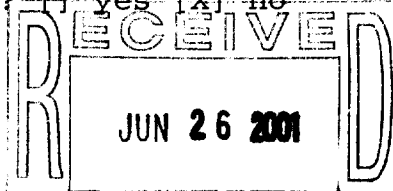

A. Grantor warrants and represents that it has full right to convey the interest assigned by this agreement, and that it has not executed and will not execute any agreement in conflict with this Assignment.


