reexaminations, corrections, substitutes, extensions or foreign equivalents thereof, and including without limitation the subject matter of all claims which may be obtained therefrom, rights of priority under International Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property, the Inter-American Convention Relating to Patents, Design and Industrial Models, and any other international agreements to which the United States adheres; together with all income, royalties, damages, claims and payments now or hereafter due or payable with respect thereto, and in and to all causes of action (either in law or in equity) and the right to sue, counterclaim, and recover for any and all legal and equitable claims for past, present and/or future infringement or other unauthorized use of the rights assigned to Assignee hereunder.

Assignor authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks, or any foreign equivalent thereto, to record Assignee as owner of the Patent Properties, and to issue any and all letters patent of the United States thereon to Assignee, as assignee of the entire, title and interest in, to and under the same, for the sole use and enjoyment of Assignee, its successors, assigns or other legal representatives.



duly executed below, on the dates indicated, by their duly authorized officers.


