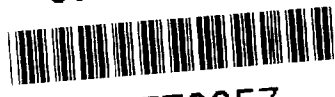


ASSIGNMENT ACCOMPANYING APPLICATION


