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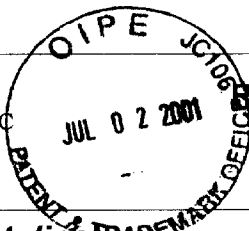



WHEREAS, we Michael A. Hiskey, David E. Chavez and Darren Naud,

have invented certain new and useful improvements in PREPARATION OF 3,3'-AZOBIS(6-AMINO-1,2,4,5-TETRAZINE)
for which we are about to file an application for United States Letters Patent identified as S-94,782;
