NOW, THEREFORE, ASSIGNOR hereby agrees to the following:

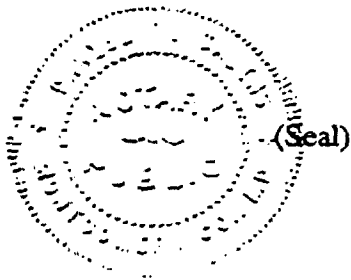


