WHEREAS, Richard John Dickinson, hereinafter call the "Assignor", has invented a new and useful Light-irradiating Sample Analyser for a full description of which reference is here made to an application for Letters Patent of the United States Serial No. 29/141,199, filed May 1, 2001; and


invention may issue.
