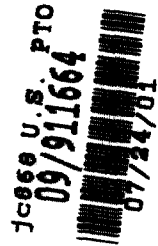

ASSIGNMENT OF UNITED STATES PATENT APPLICATION


WHEREAS, I, **Stewart B. Kelland**, of Waterloo, Ontario, Canada, have invented certain new and useful improvements in **METHOD OF PROCESSING ITEMS IN A CHECK PROCESSING SYSTEM AND AN APPARATUS THEREFOR**, Docket No. **9168.00**, for which I have executed an application for Letters Patent of the United States on same date herewith, respectively; and

Further, I agree that I will communicate to said NCR Corporation, or its representatives, any facts known to me respecting said invention, and testify in any legal proceeding, sign all lawful papers, execute all divisional, continuation, substitution, renewal and reissue applications, execute all necessary assignment papers to cause any and all of said Letters Patent to be issued to said NCR Corporation, make all rightful oaths and generally to do everything possible to aid said NCR Corporation, its successors and assigns, to obtain and enforce protection for said invention in the United States and in any and all foreign countries.
