ASSIGNMENT OF THE INVENTION

WHEREAS, We, JOHN E. NASH, residing at 1201 North Chester Springs Road, County of Chester, Chester Springs, PA 19425, GREGORY WALTERS, residing at 513 Swedesford Road, County of Chester, Malvern, PA 19353, DOUGLAS G. EVANS, residing at 202 Foxtail Lane, County of Chester, Downingtown, PA 19335, DAVID SZABO, residing at 734 Gilbert Place, County of Montgomery, Trappe, PA 19426 and MICHAEL PARIS, residing at 21 South Main Street, County of Montgomery, Hatfield, PA 19440, have made a certain new and useful invention in a TOOL FOR FACILITATING THE CONNECTING OF A CATHETER OR OTHER TUBULAR MEMBER ONTO A GUIDE-WIRE WITHOUT ACCESS TO THE ENDS OF THE GUIDE-WIRE, and have filed an application for Letters Patent of the United States based thereon on May 21, 2001, and assigned Application Serial No. 09/861,728;
