## ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, WE, Peter Y. Zhou, a citizen of the United States, residing at 49 Grandview Lane, Smithtown, New York 11787, and Dexing Pang, a citizen of China, residing at 227A Route 111, Smithtown, New York 11787, hereinafter ASSIGNORS, have invented certain new and useful improvements in U.S. Patent Application Serial No. 09/608,095, entitled SYSTEM AND METHOD FOR REMOTELY MONITORING and filed on June 30, 2000; U.S. Patent Application Serial No. 09/813,477, entitled SYSTEM AND METHOD FOR REMOTELY MONITORING and filed on March 21, 2001; and International Application No. PCT/US01/21189, entitled SYSTEM AND METHOD FOR REMOTELY MONITORING and filed on July 2, 2001;

WHEREAS, DIGITAL ANGEL CORPORATION, a Delaware corporation having a place of business at 490 East Villaume Avenue, South St. Paul, Minnesota 55075, hereinafter referred to as ASSIGNEE, is desirous of obtaining the entire right, title and interest in, to and under the said improvements and the said application:

AND WE HEREBY covenant that we have full right to convey the entire interest herein assigned, and that we have not executed, and will not execute, any agreement in conflict herewith.

AND WE HEREBY further covenant and agree that we will communicate to the ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, any facts known to us respecting said improvements, and testify in any legal proceeding, sign all lawful papers, execute all divisional, continuing and reissue applications, make all rightful oaths and generally do everything possible to aid the said ASSIGNEE, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, to obtain and enforce proper patent protection for said improvements in all countries.

AND WE HEREBY grant to the firm of Stroock & Stroock & Lavan the right and full power of attorney to enter all further identifying information of the improvements and the applications as may be deemed necessary or desirable for the recordation of this ASSIGNMENT in the United States Patent and Trademark Office.
