ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS WE, DAVID J. SELLMYER and CHUNPING LUO are the Inventors of the invention titled "EXTREMELY HIGH DENSITY MAGNETIC RECORDING MEDIA, WITH PRODUCTION METHODOLOGY CONTROLLED LONGITUDINAL/PERPENDICULAR ORIENTATION, GRAIN SIZE AND COERCIVITY"; and

WHEREAS WE are the owners of record of a United States Patent Application of the title recited above which is being submitted to the United States Patent Office, the Serial Number of which is 09/ 803,769 ; (to be filled-in when available), and

WHEREAS the Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska is desirous of accepting an Assignment of any and all interest in said Application(s) for Patent(s) and Patent(s) which Issue thereon, Domestic and Foreign, Present and Future as provided for in said Agreement or Employment Contract with the Inventors;

NOW THEREFORE, in recognition of the receipt of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good, valuable and sufficient consideration received from the Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska, WE, DAVID J. SELLMYER and CHUNPING LUO, while retaining any right to share in Royalties, do:

1. Hereby Sell, Assign, Transfer and/or otherwise Set Over Without Reservation and conditions other than those recited herein, to the Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska, its Legal Representatives, Successors, Assigns etc. the entire interest in the Rights and Title to any Patent Applications and Patents which Issue thereon, Domestic and Foreign, Present and Future, for said Invention and Improvements; so that the Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska shall hereafter own all Rights and Title as fully and completely as WE would have owned said Rights and Title were the present Assignment not made, with the full understanding that the entire Rights and Title to said Invention shall immediately vest, irrevocably, in the Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska, its Legal Representatives, Successors, Assigns etc.

2. Agree to execute all future documents as may be necessary to acquire issue of the Patent Application and additional Patents Applications for said Invention, and Improvements thereto, in the United States and in Foreign Countries.

3. Request that the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks in the United States and the equivalent in Foreign Countries issue United States Patent Application, Serial Number 09/ 803,769 , (to be filled-in when available), and such additional Patent Applications, Domestic or Foreign which result from 803,769 Patent Cooperation Treaty Patent Application, Foreign or Domestic Patent Applications to the Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska, its Legal Representatives, Successors, Assigns etc., as the case might at the Issue Date thereof.

4. Agree that WE will, at no time, do anything to jeopardize the validity of any Patent or Patent Application, Domestic or Foreign, Present or Future other than as necessitated by the duty of Truthful Disclosure required during the normal course of Patent Application Prosecution or Litigation before an Examining or Judicial Authority.

SELLMYER and CHUNPING LUO IN RECOGNITION OF GOOD, VALUABLE AND SUFFICIENT CONSIDERATION RECEIVED FROM THE BOARD OF REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NEBRASKA, AND I, DONALD W. HELMUTH, AS AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE OF THE BOARD OF REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NEBRASKA, AFFIX OUR SIGNATURES TO EFFECT THE TERMS OF THIS ASSIGNMENT, SAID SIGNATURES EACH BEING AFFIXED IN THE PRESENCE OF A NOTARY PUBLIC.


