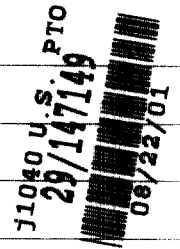

ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, **Richard C. Helmstetter**, residing at P. O. Clausen**, residing at 1190 Lake Ridge Drive, San Marcos, California 92069, and all being citizens of the United States; and **Robert R.
