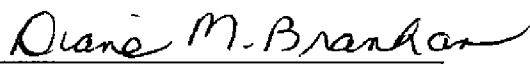

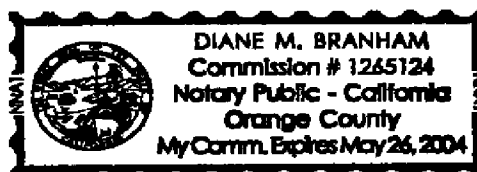

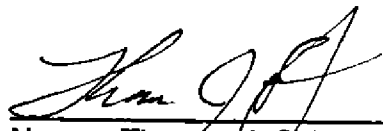
NOW, THEREFORE,
