## **NUNC PRO TUNC ASSIGNMENT**

**WHEREAS**, U.S. Patent Application Serial No. 29/052,215, filed March 26, 1996, now issued as U.S. Patent No. Des. 402,360, for a Blade Medallion for a Ceiling Fan, is a continuation of Serial No. 29/017,354, filed January 11, 1994, now abandoned, which is a division of 29/010,231, filed June 29, 1993, now abandoned (hereinafter "PATENT APPLICATIONS");

Bradford Circle, Corona, California 91720 is desirous of acquiring all right, title, and interest of the Assignor in and to said PATENT APPLICATIONS, effective as of August 30, 1993;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the payment by ASSIGNEE to ASSIGNOR of the sum of One Dollar (\$1), and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, ASSIGNOR does hereby sell, transfer, and assign **NUNC PRO TUNC** unto the said ASSIGNEE, its successors, assigns and other legal representatives, for the territory of the United States of

America and throughout the world, the entire right, title and interest in and to the said PATENT APPLICATIONS, together with any and all reissues, reexaminations, statutory invention registrations, modifications and extensions thereof, together with any and all continuations, divisions, continuations-in-part and reissues, and all of the inventions relating to the foregoing, and including all rights to claim priority, and hereby authorizes and requests the Commissioner of Patents for the country involved to issue any and all patents on inventions resulting from the PATENT APPLICATIONS or other applications to ASSIGNEE as ASSIGNEE of the entire right, title and interest therein, all of the foregoing to be held and enjoyed by ASSIGNEE for its own use and for the use of its successors, assigns or other legal representatives, together with all of the income, royalties, damages and payments now or hereafter due or payable with respect thereto, and all claims for damages by reason of past, present and future infringement of the rights assigned under this ASSIGNMENT with the right to sue for and collect the same for its own use and benefit, and for the use and benefit of its successors, assigns and other legal representatives, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and enjoyed by ASSIGNOR if this transfer to ASSIGNEE had not been made.


